Four Steps in the Event of an Emergency

ACTIVATION OF THE PLAN:

Decision to Activate: will be made by two people (Facilitator/Board member/Coordinator) Criteria: The event fulfills two out of three conditions:

- 1. Interrupts normal daily lives
- 2. Poses a risk to lives and property
- 3. Could require external assistance

Activation will be communicated via cell/text/radio

COORDINATORS TO REMEMBER:

- Family First
- The greatest good for the most people

1. Initial Response

- Coordinators in teams of 3 go to designated homes to
 - a. Check on elderly, children, adults, and pets
 - b. Identify need for medical attention
 - c. Perform quick inventory of damages to homes
- After doing assessment, coordinators communicate with facilitator via radios to report
 - a. Need for search and rescue
 - b. Need for medical/first aid assistance
 - c. Threats to safety (for example, live wires)
 - d. Status of designated houses

2. Triage and Treatment

- --Pool area will be used for medical triage for those who are injured.
- --Pool will be easier to access for ambulances.
- --Medical personnel on Plum Island: Dr. Lisa Zacharewics, Dr. Melissa Stoppler, Ilana Cood (nurse). Sandy Kennaugh (nurse), Dr. Allan Hotti, Angelica Hotti (nurse), Dr. Ken Tsiang and Dr. Julie Chen-Li (both dentists).

Evacuation

By Land

If advised by CERT, homeowners will relocate temporarily to

- --Location recommended by CERT or other official agency (Fire Dept., Police Dept.)
- --If no location is suggested by CERT, homeowners will go to
 - -- The turnaround area at the entrance of Plum Island or.
 - -- Sea Cloud Park by the snack shack (if necessary)
- --Responsible: Board member #1 (HOA President)
- Via the lagoon
 - -- There are currently 13 boats on Plum Island
 - --The possible boarding sites are by the tot lot, by the flagpole, or by the electrical tower
 - --Responsible: Board member #2 (HOA Treasurer)

4. Shelter

- --It is best if people stay in their homes if structures are safe/habitable.
- --Homeowners should ensure adequate supplies for humans and pets.
- -- The tennis courts can accommodate tents and tables, supplies, if needed.
- --Bathrooms are available in the pool area.
- --Establish shelter for pets next to tennis courts fence
- --Responsible: Board member #3 (HOA Secretary)

Communication is critical

- -- The Facilitator will serve as point person for communications among coordinators (via walkie talkies).
- -- Coordinators will relay information to residents in assigned homes.
- --Board member #1 (HOA President) will be responsible for communication with people outside of Plum Island (via a HAM radio operator). We have two licensed ham radio operators on site.
